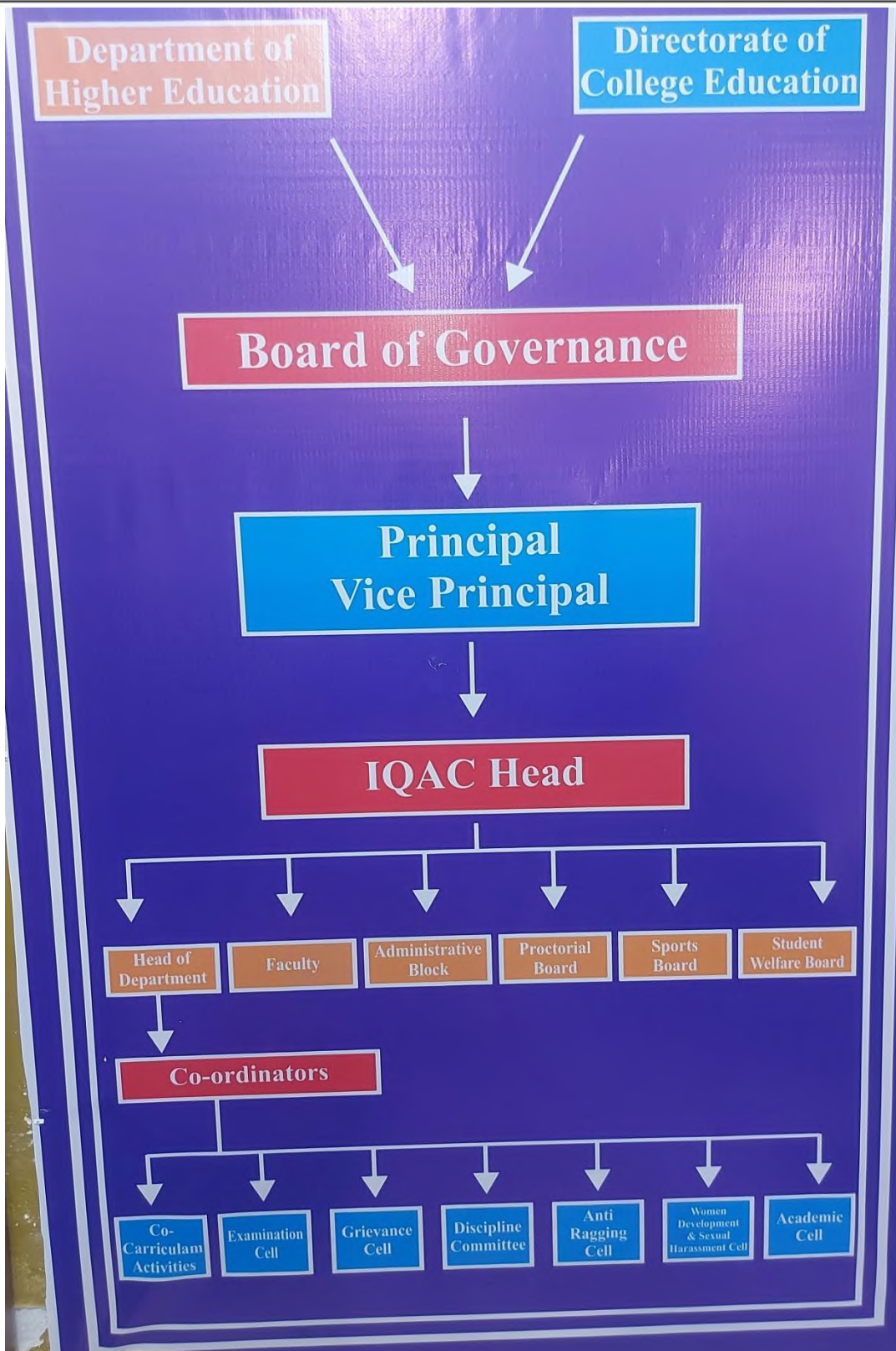

BOARD OF GOVERNING BODY Minutes of Meeting

On May 6, 2023, the Board of Governors met in the Seminar Hall. The topics on the agenda have been considered, and the board of governors' recommendations is listed here;

- The committee deliberated and formulated academic regulations, admission policies, and the curriculum for a course with added value.
- Reviewed the results of the meeting from the previous year. The goal of these deliberations and choices was to create precise rules and specifications for the curriculum of the value-added course, student admissions, and academic procedures.
- The budget was distributed by the committee for the 2023–2024 academic year. Determining the available funds and allocating them wisely to support diverse academic activities, programs, and initiatives was the goal of this discussion.
- The group had discussions about the college's academic improvements. These talks aimed to pinpoint problem areas and implement solutions to raise the standard of instruction and academic procedures.
- The committee talked on the allocation of scholarships for the upcoming session. Reviewing the scholarship program, assessing the requirements for eligibility, and allocating monies to worthy students were the goals of these conversations.
- The committee deliberated over significant prior events organized by the college in addition to upcoming activities. These talks had the goals of evaluating the accomplishments of past events, pinpointing areas in need of development, and organizing future activities that would enhance students' college experiences and involve the larger community.
- The committee talked about how the college needs more sophisticated security measures. These talks aimed to improve security procedures, solve issues pertaining to campus safety, and guarantee the welfare of personnel, instructors, and students.
- Arranged for the formulation of policies for alumni, faculty, and students, and carried them out in accordance with Mumbai University's governing regulations and the guidelines set forth by the University Grant Commission.
- The committee talked on the Governor's Report, which details the institution's accomplishments, progress, and strategic strategy. A review of the institution's performance, a list of noteworthy achievements, and a strategic plan for the future are all included in the Governor's Report.
- The committee took into account the suggestions made by a selection committee that was
