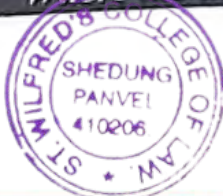

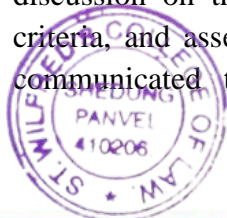

Minutes:
